



North Central Fayette County Wildlife Management Cooperative Scholarship

Purpose: To offer financial assistance to youth pursuing higher education in the fields of wildlife or agriculture.

Eligibility:

- *Applicant must have a parent, grandparent, or guardian who has been a member of NCFCWMC for 4 years, and is a current member in good standing.
- *Applicant must be pursuing a course of study related to wildlife or agriculture.
- *Applicant must be a senior in high school (or the equivalent thereof) scheduled to graduate in spring 2020.
- * Applicant must be accepted at an accredited college, university, or vocational/technical school.

Requirements:

- *Completed application with typed essay.
- *Current transcript including rank and GPA.

Deadline:

- *Must be postmarked on or before April 15, 2020.

Disbursal Procedures:

*Winning applicant will receive a total of \$2,000. A check will be disbursed for \$1,000 each semester to be used toward tuition or other education-related expenses.

To receive fall disbursement: provide letter of acceptance and class schedule for fall.

To receive spring disbursement: provide copy of grades (GPA of 2.0 or higher) and class schedule for spring semester.

*Scholarship must be accepted within the calendar year of being awarded, or scholarship money will be returned to the NCFCWMC.

*Payment will be made when NCFCWMC has received proof of enrollment at an accredited college, university, or technical/vocational school.

*Scholarship recipient will be chosen by the NCFCWMC scholarship committee.

Award: The scholarship recipient will receive:

*\$2,000 cash award (\$1,000 each semester for 1 year).

*Certificate of award

*1 year paid membership to NCFCWMC

*1 year subscription to the NCFCWMC newsletter

*Invitation to attend and opportunity to speak at annual meeting (Oct. 2020)
